

Enhancing Temperature Controlled Logistics Functions in Southern Vietnam New Warehouse Starts Operation at Anpha-AG Joint Stock Company

Providing a one-stop storage, trunk line transportation, and distribution service to handle increasing amounts of food

On Thursday July 16, 2026, Anpha-AG Joint Stock Company (Headquarters: Tây Ninh, Vietnam; Representative: Koichi Kawase; Hereinafter “Anpha-AG”), group company of Konoike Transport Co., Ltd. (Headquarters: Chuo-ku, Osaka, Japan; Representative Director, Chairman, President and Chief Executive Officer: Tadahiko Konoike; Hereinafter “Konoike Transport”) started operation of its new dry-temperature/chilled warehouse for foods and food ingredients built on the Anpha-AG site in Tây Ninh, Vietnam next to its existing warehouse.

Due to increased interest in food safety and quality in Vietnam, Anpha-AG established a new warehouse to handle increased amounts of frozen/chilled and imported food, at a cost of 527 million yen. By consolidating operations of the existing frozen/chilled warehouse and the new dry-temperature/chilled warehouse, Anpha-AG has built a logistics system that can handle three temperature ranges. Anpha-AG links with the trunk line transportation and urban distribution functions of Konoike Vinatrans Logistics Co., Ltd. (Headquarters: Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam; Representative: Koichi Kawase; Hereinafter “K-Vina”), group company of Konoike Transport, with the aim of enhancing dry-temperature logistics functions in southern Vietnam.

Since becoming the first Japanese logistics company to enter the Vietnamese market in 1993, the KONOIKE Group has expanded its business with a focus on the forwarding of maritime/air-based cargo and dry-temperature logistics. The Group now operates a total of four companies* to provide services for supporting logistics infrastructure across Vietnam. These are Anpha-AG, which is involved in the frozen/chilled warehouse business and engineering business, K-Vina, in charge of frozen/chilled warehouse operations, frozen/chilled periodic trunk line transportation, and distribution to urban areas, and Vinako Forwarding Co., Ltd. and BEL International Logistics Vietnam Company Ltd., which conduct forwarding.

With the opening of this new warehouse, Anpha-AG now has a total of 15,676 m² floor space and a 26,600 pallet capacity when combined with its existing warehouse. Anpha-AG aims to expand its business in southern Vietnam by linking with K-Vina to provide integrated proposals for trunk line transportation and distribution, while leveraging high added-value services based on Japanese standards of temperature control and administration quality to meet a wide variety of demand from Japanese companies, as well as Vietnamese, South Korean, Chinese, and Western companies.

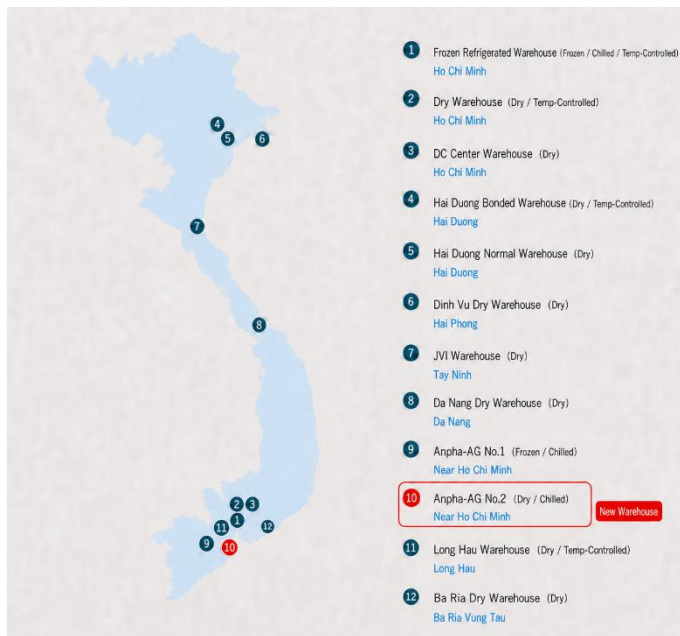
